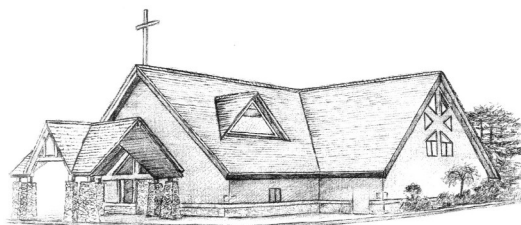

Pastors Corner

I want to thank you all for taking the time to listen at the Masses about our increased giving campaign, *Sharing Our Gifts*. This weekend I will be speaking at the two Spanish Masses and the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. More importantly I would love to see all the people that come to our parish officially registered. In the midst of all the day to day operations we are updating the parish census records. This is a monumental undertaking which we are still working on. If you have moved, changed your telephone number or anything else you need to let us know.

Starting in January, if you are not using the envelope system we will start removing people off the list. I do not want to do this, but we are receiving too many envelopes back and the postage is starting to add up. (Yes, we pay for the postage and your envelopes.) An alternative to the envelope system (you still need to register at the parish) is Parish Pay. You can sign up on the parish website. You will be able to track your collections and also help you with you with your tax statements. Take a look and see if it is for you.

This weekend please take a look at the new mass schedule. We must prepare for the time when there are only three priests here or less. We are blessed in this parish but they can be moved to help assist at other parishes that have only one priest. Canon Law states that a priest can only offer two masses a day. Before we had too many masses and if we have three thousand families attending between the various masses, that is only two hundred and fifty people at church which seats four hundred people. You see why it is important that we reduce the number of Masses now, rather than later. Change is hard for some especially with the elimination of the 10:15 a.m. Mass but it is now necessary.

Finally on November 2 at 7:00 p.m. we will have a special Mass for the Feast of All Souls. November is the month for all of those who have passed before us and we need to always remember and pray for them. Names of those deceased in the past year will be read at the Mass on November 2. You and your family are encouraged to attend to remember your loved on this day and know they are part of the great holy communion of the church.

officiellement enregistrés. Les opérations quotidiennes nous
permettent de toujours actualiser les dossiers de recensement
qui a toute son importance. Pour tous changements relatifs à
votre fichier (changement d'adresse, de numéro de
téléphone...), prière de nous en informer.

Nous enregistrons un nombre assez élevé d'enveloppes
retournées à la paroisse et, ce que cela coûte en frais postage,
me pousse à prendre la décision d'éliminer, à partir du mois
de Janvier 2016, les noms de ceux qui n'utilisent pas le
système d'enveloppe. Vous pouvez aussi vous inscrire sur le
site de la paroisse qui vous donne l'opportunité de suivre vos
collections et également avoir votre état de compte pour la
saison fiscale.

Ce week-end veuillez prendre connaissance du nouvel
horaire des messes. Nous devons nous préparer à toute
éventualité de réduction de l'effectif des prêtres. Jusque-là
nous sommes bénis dans cette paroisse, mais à tout moment
ils peuvent être déplacés pour aider d'autres paroisses. Le
Droit Canon affirme que le prêtre peut offrir seulement deux
messes par jour. Le Dimanche, nous avons actuellement dix
messes pour environ trois mille familles cependant deux cent
cinquante personnes en moyenne assistent à chaque messe
alors que l'église a quatre cents places (assises). Voilà
pourquoi il est important que nous réduisons le nombre de
messes maintenant, avant qu'il soit trop tard. Le changement
est difficile pour certains, surtout avec l'élimination de la
messe de 10:15 le dimanche, mais il est nécessaire.

Enfin, le 2 Novembre à 7h00 pm, nous aurons une messe
spéciale pour la fête de la Toussaint. Le mois de Novembre
est consacré à ceux qui nous ont devancés dans la maison du
Père et dont nous avons besoin de toujours nous souvenir et
prier pour eux. Nous aurons une intention spéciale pour tous
les paroissiens décédés au cours de cette année. Vous et
votre famille êtes encouragés à y assister et retenir vos
proches ce jour-là et sachez qu'ils font partie de la grande et
sainte communion de l'église.

Rincón del Párroco: Quiero agradecerles a todos por tomarse el tiempo en las Misas para escuchar acerca de nuestra campaña de aumento de donaciones, Compartiendo nuestros regalos. Este fin de semana voy a estar hablando sobre esto en las dos Misas en español y en la Misa del Sábado a las 5:00 p.m. Más importante, me encantaría ver a todas las personas que vienen a nuestra parroquia oficialmente registradas en la parroquia. En medio de todas las labores diarias, estamos actualizando los registros del censo de la parroquia. Esta es una tarea monumental, en la cual todavía estamos trabajando. Si usted se ha mudado, cambiado su número de teléfono o cualquier otra cosa, usted necesita dejarnos saber.

A partir de enero, si usted no está utilizando el sistema de sobres vamos a empezar a eliminar personas de la lista. No quiero hacer esto, pero estamos recibiendo demasiados sobres de regreso y las estampillas están empezando a acumularse. (Sí, nosotros pagamos los gastos de envío y los sobres.) Una alternativa al sistema de sobres (siempre tienen que registrarse en la parroquia) es Parish Pay. Usted puede inscribirse a Parish Pay a través de la página web de la parroquia. Usted podrá estar al tanto de sus colecciones y también le ayudará con sus declaraciones de impuestos. Revise Parish Pay y vea si es algo para usted.

Este fin de semana por favor revise el nuevo horario de Misa. Debemos prepararnos para el momento en que sólo tengamos tres sacerdotes aquí, o menos. Hemos sido bendecidos en esta parroquia, pero ellos pueden ser movidos para ayudar a asistir a otras parroquias que tienen un solo sacerdote. La Ley Canónico dice que un sacerdote sólo puede ofrecer dos Misas al día. Antes teníamos demasiadas Misas. Si tenemos tres mil familias que asisten entre las múltiples Misas, sólo son doscientos cincuenta personas en la Iglesia, la cual tiene la capacidad de cuatrocientas personas. Ahora ves por qué es importante que reduzcamos el número de Misas ahora, en lugar de más tarde. El cambio es difícil para algunos, especialmente con la eliminación de la Misa de las 10:15 am, pero ahora es necesario.

Finalmente el 2 de noviembre a las 7:00 pm tendremos una Misa especial para la fiesta de Todos los Santos. Noviembre es el mes para todos los que han pasado antes que nosotros y tenemos que recordar y orar por ellos siempre. Los nombres de los fallecidos en el último año se leerán en la Misa el 2 de noviembre. Usted y su familia están invitados a asistir para recordar a sus seres queridos en este día y saber que son parte de la gran comunión santa de la Iglesia.
